Extended Tax Cuts for Beaver County Families

In December 2010, Congressman Altmire voted to extend all of the 2001 and 2003 tax cuts through the end of 2012. The Middle Class Tax Relief Act -- which went into effect on December 17, 2010 – will help provide Americans with the certainty needed to make long-term investments and spur job growth by extending the current lower tax rates for another two years. Championing the Repeal of the 1099 Provision in the Health Care Reform Law

Congressman Altmire is a cosponsor of the Small Business Paperwork Mandate Elimination Act which repeals the 1099 provision in the health care reform law. The Act eliminates the requirement that small businesses file a 1099 tax form for every business from which they have purchased more than \$600 in goods and services in a single year. The 1099 provision is a burden on small businesses and its repeal will allow them to focus on growing and creating jobs, instead of filling out unnecessary paperwork.
