(WASHINGTON, D.C.) -- U.S. Congressman Jason Altmire (PA-04) has voted for legislation that will provide America's Armed Forces with the support that they need to effectively carry out their missions. The FY 2010 Supplemental Appropriations Act (H.R. 4899) passed the House last night and must still be approved by the Senate before it can be signed into law.

**"I will never vote against funding that supports and equips our troops," Congressman Altmire said. "We owe it to our men and women in uniform to ensure they have all the resources that they need to serve and protect our country."**

The FY 2010 Supplemental Appropriations Act will provide much-needed funding for Americans serving in Iraq and Afghanistan. Specifically, this funding will help to replace damaged equipment, improve force protection, and support key readiness programs that will prepare troops for combat operations and other missions.
