WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Congressman Jason Altmire (PA-04) today announced that the B.F. Jones Memorial Library in Aliquippa, PA will receive a \$5,650 Preservation Assistance Grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH). The grant will allow the library to hire a consultant to conduct a preservation assessment of the library's collection of newspaper clippings, photographs, yearbooks, and steel industry documents.

"The documents in this library contain important information regarding the history of western Pennsylvania, as well as the steel industry's impact on our region,"

Congressman Altmire said.

"I congratulate the B.F. Jones Memorial Library for receiving this grant, and I look forward to working with them to keep this important information available for public viewing."
