Pennsylvania 4th District Congressman Jason Altmire set a milestone in his career as a Congressman on Wednesday.

Altmire, a Democrat, cast his 4,000th vote as a Congressman on an amendment to the Jobs and Energy Permitting act. The amendment failed 183-238.

His unbroken vote streak began when he took office Jan. 4, 2007 and he has never missed a vote. Altmire remains the only member of Congress to have made every vote called during the past three sessions of Congress and his 4,000 votes is the longest streak of any current member.
